Hero Sandwich

What do you call a sandwich stuffed with cold cuts and cheese? If you live in New England, it's a grinder; on the West Coast, a submarine. Order one in Philadelphia, and it's a hoagie; in New Orleans, a muffuletta. But for Dad on Father's Day there's only one name for it: a hero sandwich.

1. Cut a loaf of French bread in half lengthwise.
2. Layer on slices of ham, turkey, salami, and Provolone, Swiss or American cheese.
3. Top with shredded lettuce and sliced tomatoes.
4. Add onions. Optional - add pickles, olives and hot peppers, if desired.
5. Spread on mayonnaise, honey mustard, or mustard, or drizzle with Italian salad dressing.
6. Serve with potato chips, corn chips or pretzels and an ice-cold glass of lemonade.
