

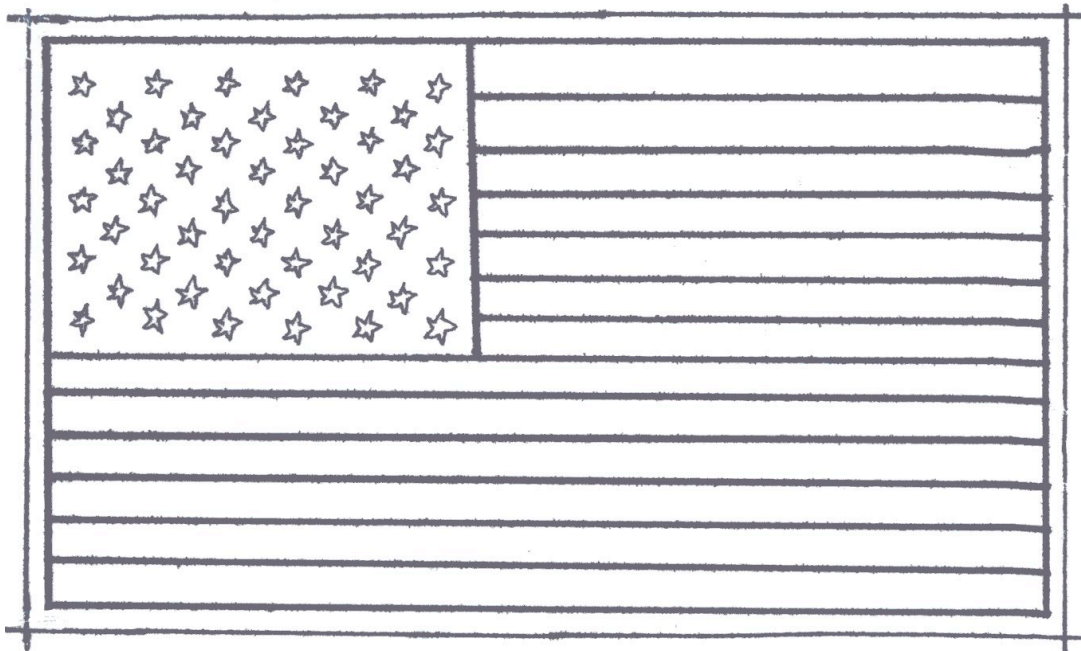

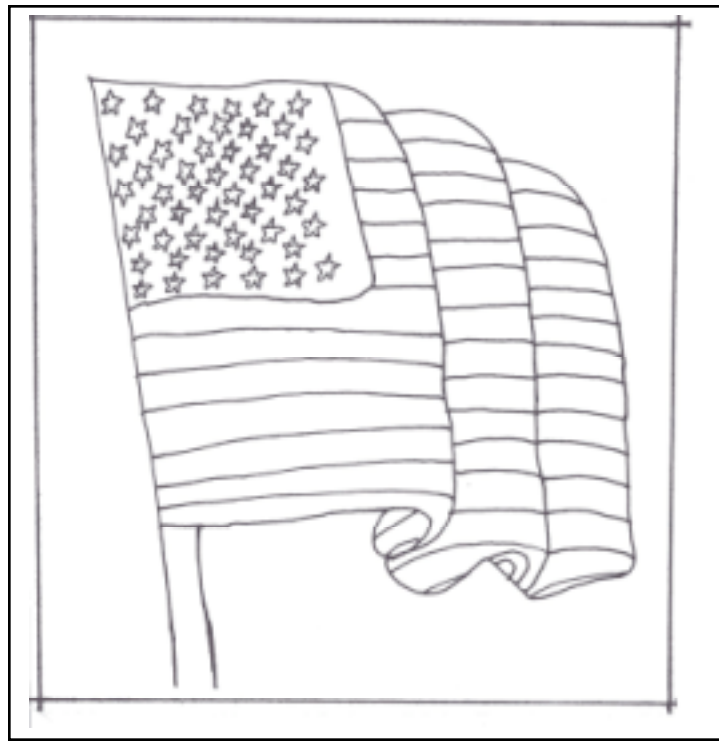


There are 50 stars representing all the states in the United States and 13 alternating red and white stripes representing the 13 original colonies. (Begin with red.)
